

# Master's in Supply Chain Management Accelerated Degree Program (ADP)

Marquette University offers an Accelerated Degree Program that allows students to earn a bachelor's degree and master of science degree in supply chain management in as little as five years.

## Why you should consider an ADP in supply chain management?

- Six credits earned your senior year will count toward both degrees.
- Complete the master's program in 12 months.
- Work or secure an internship to gain industry experience during fifth year, as classes are conducted online (class load of six to nine credit hours per semester).
- Overall reduced cost for master's program.
- Pay for 24 graduate credits with ADP vs. 30 credits.
- Huge digital SCM skills shortage in industry.

Students may apply for the ADP program in their junior year. Students must have a GPA of 3.00 or higher to be considered eligible to apply. For admission process and additional information, contact:
