In 1983, the museum's founding director, Curtis L. Carter, invited then-emerging artist Keith Haring to create a series of paintings on the plywood fence, now an important early example of Haring's large-scale, site-specific public art projects. Portions of *Construction Fence* are on view in the museum this summer through August 30. The Haring t-shirt is for sale at the museum for \$15.
