

Business Course/Discovery Tier Theme: Dual Apply Business Courses to Reduce Overall Minimum Credit Requirements

For use by students who started at Marquette University in Fall 2019 and beyond. The university allows a maximum of two courses in the Discovery Tier Theme to apply towards a primary major. The College of Business Administration allows up to two business courses (excludes CMST 2300, MATH 1400, PHIL 4330, Et al.) in a student's declared Discovery Tier Theme to dual apply towards business core, major course work and/or upper division business electives to reduce the overall number of credits a student needs to graduate by a maximum of 6 credits (or two courses).

Submit one form for each course need, a maximum of two courses. Complete form after class has been completed with a final grade, unless during a student's final semester at Marquette University.
