Marquette College of Professional Studies' Future Milwaukee board dissolves; scholarship funds transferred to Tate Family Foundation

Future Milwaukee, Inc., the longtime governing body of the Future Milwaukee leadership training program, officially dissolved in September 2008. The Tate Family Foundation has been selected to serve as the fiscal agent for the remaining Future Milwaukee Inc. scholarship funds, and will be disbursing funds to Marquette on an annual basis.

For more than 30 years, Future Milwaukee has been building a diverse group of ethically-based leaders among all sectors of the Milwaukee community. This non-profit program became affiliated with Marquette University's College of Professional Studies in 2005 to further the program's mission to help create positive and sustainable change throughout the greater Milwaukee area.

"The generous support of Future Milwaukee Inc., through its scholarship funds for Marquette University's College of Professional Studies, is a very important step for the continued solid growth and delivery of this leadership program in our community," said Bob Deahl, dean of the college.
