The presentation discusses the education, experiences and choices made by a medical imaging graduate student to land a job at Samsung and General Electric. It will cover both technical and non-technical aspects of becoming and working as a software engineer for a world-leading medical imaging systems manufacturer. The topics will include my graduate research work in the field of medical imaging, software engineering practices, working with multinational teams, and things that I may have done differently if I had another chance at school.
