History: Notre Dame Church is a non-Indian parish. However, diocesan priests from Notre Dame/ St. Mary attended the following Ojibwa Indian mission and station:

1860-1880 (became a mission)	Flambeaufarm station, and in 1880, St. Francis of Assisi Mission, Flambeau (from 1879-1880 attended jointly with the Franciscans from Bayfield, Superior, and Ashland)
1880-1906 (transferred to St. Mary's, Bruce)	St. Francis of Assisi Mission, Flambeau (from attended jointly with the Franciscans from Bayfield, Superior, and Ashland)
