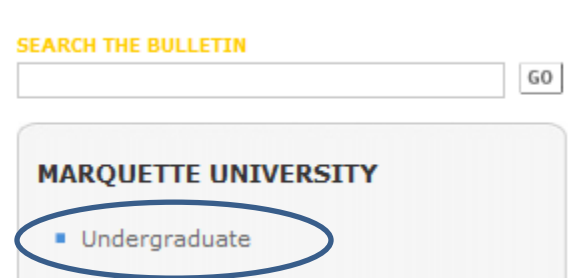

The major in history requires the following 33 semester hours:

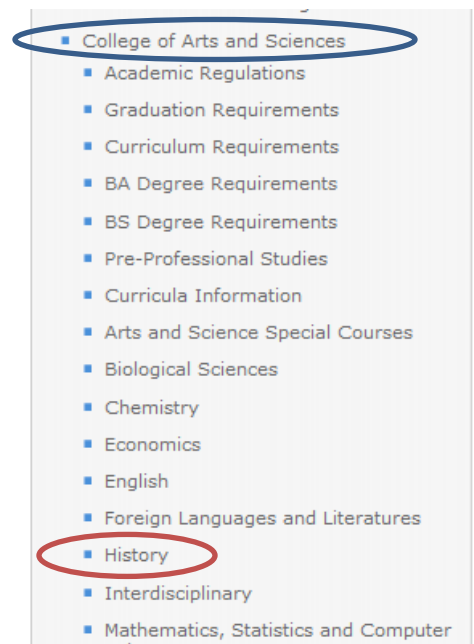

Tab Search:

Across the top (below the blue Marquette University Bulletin heading) are various tabs to **Bulletin Home**, **A-Z Directory**, **Bulletin Contents**, **Previous Bulletins** and **PDF version**. Each of these tabs works in conjunction with the other search features to bring forward the information needed:



- The **Bulletin Home** tab directs users back to the home page from any page within the university bulletin.
- The **A-Z Directory** tab lists the pages of information throughout the university bulletin in A-Z format.
- The **Bulletin Contents** tab lists the bulletin content in order of the URL address.
- The **Previous Bulletins** tab allows users to view the PDF version of previous undergraduate and graduate bulletins.
- The **PDF Version** tab allows users to print the current university bulletin.
