Gender Resource Center
Faculty Fellowships Supporting Research in Gender/Sexuality
Call for Proposals**

Marquette University's Office of the Provost will award, in conjunction with the establishment of the Gender Resource Center, up to 6 research fellowships to Marquette faculty for the month of June, 2012. The purpose of the fellowship awards will be to provide research support for Marquette University faculty currently engaged in scholarly or creative work in gender or sexuality studies. Faculty with work in progress or in need of support for exploratory research are encouraged to apply.

Each award will provide a stipend of \$5,000 for the month of June, 2012 for the sole support of advancing a research or creative project. Eligible awardees must hold permanent tenure track appointments at Marquette University, have terminal degrees, and be returning to the university for the 2012-13 academic year. A report on the results of the project will be due by September 15, 2012.

Proposals must be submitted to William Welburn, Associate Provost for Diversity and Inclusion, by Friday March 9, 2012. Submissions should not exceed 3-4 pages in length and should include the following information:

- An abstract of not more than 300 words, written for a nonspecialist audience, stating how the work and its outcomes are related to larger disciplinary or multidisciplinary issues.
- A brief description of the project, its objectives, methods and work plan, stage of completion, significance to the field, and how the project relates to other work the applicant has published or completed.
- The applicant or applicants' CV(s).
- A brief note of endorsement from the applicant's department chair or dean.

All submitted proposals will be reviewed by a panel of Marquette University faculty, and awardees will be notified before April 1, 2012.
