Way Klingler Young Scholar Award

2010 Application

The purpose of **Way Klingler Young Scholar Award** is to support promising young scholars in critical stages of their careers. Up to four awards will be given for 2010-11 to full-time regular junior faculty in the three years following their third year review. The awards of up to \$32,000 are intended to fund \$2,000 in operating cost and to cover up to 50% of salary to afford the recipient a one semester sabbatical. The award is competitive and will be selected by the Committee on Research.

Applications including support letters from the department chair and dean are due by **January 11, 2010** (Check with your dean's office to confirm the college application deadline.). Individuals selected will be notified by March 1, 2010 and will select a Fall 2010 or Spring 2011 sabbatical by agreement with the dean. A complete application consists of:

1. Name
2. Academic Rank
3. Year of original full-time appointment
4. Year of third year review
5. Home address and phone number
6. University address and phone number
7. E-Mail address
8. Program of research and research goals (limit to two pages)
9. Publications starting with most recent
10. Grants past, current and pending
11. Plan for semester sabbatical*
12. Copy of Third Year Review Report

Please prepare using 12 point font with 1" margins.

**Where relevant, funds will be held until approval from the University Institutional Review Board is submitted.*
