Time to Completion

The mean number of years that students have taken to complete the doctoral program for students entering with their bachelor's degree was 6.7 (median = 7); for students entering with a master's degree (n=3) the mean was 3.33 (median 3).

Program Costs

For students entering the program in the 2007-08 academic year, the cost of tuition will be \$800 per credit hour. As of 2007-08, students must complete 84 credit hours for completion of Ph.D. For each of the last five years, each and every doctoral student entering with a bachelor's degree (versus those entering with MS degrees) received a full graduate assistantship, which included full tuition and a stipend that presently amounts to approximately \$1100 per month for the academic year, their first two years, and approximately three-fourths of a graduate assistantship their third year. Most students obtain psychology-related work (e.g., working for a

psychologist administering tests) or teach after their third year.
